# FIRST+MAIN FILMS LAUNCHES UN-HABITAT BETTER CITIES FILM FESTIVAL AT THE 11th WORLD URBAN FORUM

# A vision for better cities and towns through the power of film.

27 JUNE 2022, KATOWICE, POLAND – First+Main Films, in partnership with the United Nations agency focused on sustainable urbanization, UN-Habitat, kicked off the UN-Habitat Better Cities Film Festival today in Katowice, Poland. Films will screen daily at the Urban Cinema inside the exposition hall of the Eleventh Session of the World Urban Forum (WUF11) from 26-30 June 2022.

Better Cities Film Festival curates and presents the best documentary and narrative films from around the world on urban issues including the theme of this year's World Urban Forum: Transforming our Cities for a Better Urban Future. For this edition of the festival, 37 films featuring nineteen countries were selected from the 245 submissions.

On the final day of the forum, awards will be presented to the best overall films, as well as the top films in six categories: Better Environment, Better Planning & Design, Better Economies For All, Better Transportation, Better Innovation & Technology, and Better Communities. Screenings include post-film discussion and conversation with filmmakers, leaders and experts from among the *World Urban Forum* participants. The World Urban Forum is the world's largest and most important conference on urban issues. It is held every two years and attracts thousands of participants including ministers, mayors, policymakers, academics, community activists, artists and journalists.

UN-Habitat's Executive Director, Maimunah Mohd Sharif said the UN-Habitat Better Cities Film Festival @WUF11 would give participants new perspectives on urban issues. "This film festival will bring an exciting dimension to the World Urban Forum," said the Executive Director. "These films infuse the forum with ideas, inspiration and imagination that will help us transform our cities."

"First+Main Films launched Better Cities Film Festival because we believe in the power of storytelling to inspire and empower cities and communities. We are proud to partner with UN-Habitat in order to bring the festival to the world's leading conference on cities," said Dr. Chris Elisara, co-founder of First+Main Films.

After WUF11 the *UN-Habitat Better Cities Film Festival's* "Best of Fest" reel will become a traveling festival available for screenings at other UN-Habitat and UN events and cities, and towns around the world.

"We look forward to 'taking the show on the road' after WUF11 and creating a way for communities everywhere to screen these stories and inspire conversation and change in their hometowns," said John Paget, co-founding partner of First+Main Films.
